THE PROLONGED ADMISSION PROCEDURE

Admission Procedure Requirements

1. Portfolio
2. Interview

Portfolio

The portfolio includes a selection of the applicant's work completed so far. As for the genre of the work of art, these can be connected to any field of media design, interactive installation, audiovisual content (e.g. video, animation, sound design, etc.), projection mapping, documented event, computer game, 3D, 2D graphics or visualization, web contents, UX design, mobile or PC applications.

Every piece of work has to be uploaded digitally, in a clear structure of files, in generally used formats. (In case of a still image: *jpg*, *png*, in case of motion picture: *mp4*, *mov*, *mpeg*).

In case of motion picture, YouTube or vimeo links are also accepted. Any other link to individual drives or websites is not accepted.

Attached to the portfolio, please submit a short summary about the works, in which you describe the conception of the work. Please upload in doc format to the folder given later via e-mail.

Compulsory appendices:

- A statement of submitting only own, independent pieces of art. The statement can be downloaded here:

- Covering letter: please cover letter brief description in, maximum one-page length of your thoughts and motivations regarding the submitted pieces and your completion of the task
- Please submit your CV, maximum one-page long
- A document proving that you have paid the admission fee.
(Please do not pay the admission procedure fee before you have received your information email containing your individual personal code provided by METU. Thank you for your patience.)

The whole size of the submitted material cannot exceed 30 MB, including the compulsory appendices

The period of uploading the portfolio and the compulsory appendices: to the storage place specified in the personal information letter.

Interview

During the conversation you will have the opportunity to present pieces of work that you find important to demonstrate your skills (e.g. digital reproductions of drawings, prints, photos, the documentation of interactive installations, the documentation of an Internet page/system, documentation of software or a game app, etc.). Animation, films or computer graphics are also accepted, the online platform is appropriate for that..

For this part of the exam you will need stable internet connection, as well as a device equipped with a camera, speakers and a microphone that can be used for a video conference.

A further condition of participating in the prolonged admission procedure is that in case the applicant holds a degree issued abroad, the applicant's request has been granted and your qualification stated in the submitted documents, school report or degree (certificate) has been accepted by Budapest Metropolitan University.

In case of accepting a degree (certificate) issued abroad for participating in higher education in Hungary, METU takes the decisions of the Hungarian Equivalence and Information Centre into consideration.

Budapest Metropolitan University takes a decision about accepting a degree (certificate) issued abroad for participating in higher education in Hungary and it is sent in a registered mail to the applicant.
