THE ADMISSION PROCESS

ADMISSION PROCEDURE REQUIREMENTS

The admission procedure comprises of an oral interview.

A conversation with the applicant about their field of interest, personal plans, professional ideas. The future professors would like to hear about the applicant's plans and ideas regarding education, future plans and perspectives. Conversation will be based on questions about these topics. The applicants have the opportunity to give a presentation about their professional ideas based on their previous studies, but it is not compulsory. The conversation provides enough opportunity for getting familiar with the applicants ideas and professional motivation.

Compulsory appendices:

- 1. Professional CV
- 2. Motivation Letter
- 3. A document proving that you have paid the admission fee.

A further condition of participating in the admission procedure is that in case the applicant holds a degree issued abroad, the applicant's request has been granted and your qualification stated in the submitted documents, school report or degree (certificate) has been accepted.

In case of accepting a degree (certificate) issued abroad for participating in higher education in Hungary, METU takes the decisions of the Hungarian Equivalence and Information Centre into consideration.

Budapest Metropolitan University takes a decision about accepting a degree (certificate) issued abroad for participating in higher education in Hungary and it is sent in a registered mail to the applicant.
